

Student Uniform and Dress Code

Purp	oose
------	------

The purpose of the Student Dress Code is to outline Grovedale West Primary School's requirements for student dress and appearance and to provide information about uniform purchase and support, consistent dress code implementation and exemption processes.

This dress code has been developed by Grovedale West Primary School's School Council in close consultation with our school community to ensure that it respects the rights of individual students whilst reflecting the values and interests of our community.

The Student Dress Code aims to:

- foster a sense of community and belonging and encourages students to develop pride in their appearance
- support Example School's commitment to ensuring that our students feel equal and are dressed safely and appropriately for school activities.
- reduce student competition on the basis of clothing
- enhance the profile and identity of the school and its students within the wider community.

The School Council has developed a dress code that we believe provides a range of choices for students and is cost effective for families.

Scope

Students are expected to comply with this Student Dress Code while traveling to and from school, during school hours and when attending school activities. Parents are advised of the dress code when enrolling their child at the school and it is published on the school website.

Uniform and Appearance

The full list of Example School's compulsory school uniform items is available at Appendix A to this policy.

General appearance

While at school, travelling to or from school or participating in school activities, Grovedale West Primary School students must comply with the following:

- Uniforms must be clean and in good repair
- Uniforms must be clearly marked with the owner's name
- Additional layers of clothing may be worn underneath the uniform for added warmth, provided these undergarments are completely hidden.
- Clothes that are not listed in the school uniform are not to be worn unless otherwise approved by the Principal.

<u>Iewellery and cosmetics</u>

Students are not permitted to wear decorative jewellery to school. Stud earnings and sleepers worn in the ears, and watches, are the only acceptable jewellery.

Cosmetics may not be worn at school. Only clear nail polish is permitted.

For safety, students should not wear nail extensions to school.

Hair and Sun safety

Shoulder length or longer hair is to be tied back to help restrict the spread of nits and lice and for student safety. Student hair should be natural colour.

School uniform hats must be worn outside from mid-August to the end of April and on any other day prescribed by the school. School uniform hats may also be worn outside of this time

	period, by parent or student choice. The school recommend that parents ensure their children wear their sun hats if walking to or from school.
	Hats and beanies are not to be worn inside.
	Students are permitted to wear sunglasses during outdoor activities. Sunglasses should be close-fitting, wrap-around that meet the Australian Standards 1067 and cover as much of the eye area as possible.
Support for families experiencing difficulty	Please contact the Principal, Chaplain or office staff to discuss support that we may be able to provide to families experiencing difficulty meeting uniform costs, including information about eligibility for uniform support through State Schools' Relief. Further information about State Schools' Relief is also available on their website: https://www.ssr.net.au/
Implementation	Grovedale West Primary School will ensure that this Student Dress Code is communicated to all families and students through our website and newsletter updates. We will assist students who may be experiencing difficulties complying with this policy where possible.
	Students wearing non-compliant uniform items may be asked to change into a compliant item of clothing provided by the school.
	If a student is out of school uniform or otherwise breaches the Student Dress Code on a recurring basis, a note will be provided to the student and parents by the classroom teacher. If non-compliance with the dress code becomes a continued occurrence, the Principal will be informed, and a phone call home may be required. In this event, the school will continue to work with the student and family to support compliance.
	Measures taken by Grovedale West Primary School to address concerns about student non-compliance with the Student Dress Code will also be addressed in accordance with our Student Wellbeing and Engagement Policy.
Exceptions to student dress	We recognise that there may be situations where the application of this dress code may affect students unequally.
code	Students and their parents or carers may apply either in writing or in person to the Principal for an exemption to this Student Dress Code if:
	 an aspect of this code prevents the student from complying with a requirement of their religious, ethnic or cultural beliefs or background the student has a particular disability or health condition that requires a departure from the dress code
	 the student or their parents/carers can demonstrate particular economic hardship that prevents them from complying with the dress code.
	When the Principal receives a request for an exemption, they will:
	 consider the grounds for the exemption request explain the process to the student and/or their parents/carers encourage the student and/or their parents/carers to support their application with evidence.
	Identify support for families demonstrate economic hardship to assist their child to have access to the appropriate school unform

	The Principal or delegate will then try to negotiate a resolution that is acceptable to all parties. If an exemption is not allowed, then written reasons will be provided to the student and/or their parents or carers.

The following items may

Polo shirts

- Short /or long sleeve green polo shirt with school logo
- Short / or long sleeve navy polo shirt with school logo
- Year 3-6 short sleeve navy polo with white side panels and school logo

Vest

Navy polar vest with school logo

Jumper

- Navy polar zip neck long sleeve jumper with school logo
- Navy button neck long sleeve jumper with school logo

Rugby

School long sleeve rugby with school logo

Skort

Navy skort to be worn with white socks

School dress

Cotton dress school colors to be worn with white socks
 A singlet or white short sleeved t-shirt is recommended for warmth under the dress if required.

School kilt (winter)

• Kilt in school colors to be worn with white socks or navy tights.

Shorts

- Navy shorts (without brand or decoration) to be worn with white socks. Shorts are to be thigh length and able to be seen below the school top.
- Brief shorts and athletic shorts should only be worn for sport.

	 Navy track pants (without brand or decoration) to be worn with navy socks School Raincoat (Optional Item) 	
	Navy Blue	
Black school	The shoes can be black runners, leather school shoes, T-bar shoes. Colored runners are not to be worn with the school uniform.	
Shoes	Opened toes shoes are not permitted for safety reasons.	
Sport clothing	 Runners can be worn on allocated sport days Year 3-6 – short sleeve navy polo with white side panels and school logo can also be worn for sport Each student is allocated to a 'House' and should have a basic t-shirt in their house color - (red, blue, yellow or green) to wear at school, house events. Senior students will be provided with specific school uniforms for some sporting activities which need to be washed by parents after use. 	
Headwear	 Headwear Navy blue, green or white head bands, hair ribbons, "scrunchies" or headwear worn as part of cultural/religious beliefs. Navy broadbrim hats (not peaked hats) Hats – to be worn from mid-August to 30 April (DET) Navy winter beanie to be worn April to August if required
